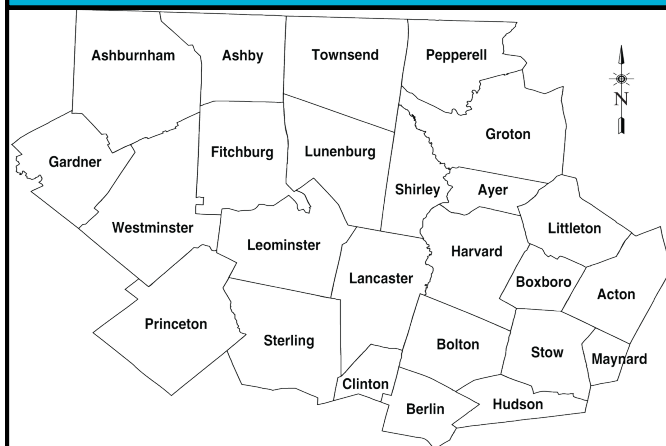
Use your Talent Join a team of volunteers working together to help us select and mentor families, fundraise, find building sites, plan events, or work with faith communities.

How Habitat Works

Through volunteer labor and tax-deductible donations of money and materials, Habitat for Humanity North Central Massachusetts builds strength, stability and self-reliance through shelter right here in our community. Habitat homes are sold to families at no profit and financed with affordable 0% interest mortgages. The homeowners' monthly payments are recycled into a revolving *Fund for Humanity* that is used to build more houses. Homeowners invest hundreds of hours of their own labor to build their home and the homes of others.
