Build strength, stability and self-reliance through shelter.




Critical Repair

Habitat for Humanity NCM provides critical repairs *with* people, not *for* people. Homeowner families must meet four requirements to be considered for the program:

- Critical repairs relate to protecting the health and safety of occupants or solve critical weatherization problems.
- Families must have the ability to pay Habitat for Humanity NCM's 0% interest loan.
- Homeowners invest sweat equity of 8 hours per \$1,000 of loan amount.
- Family income falls between 30 and 60% of the area median income and other assets not available for project.
